

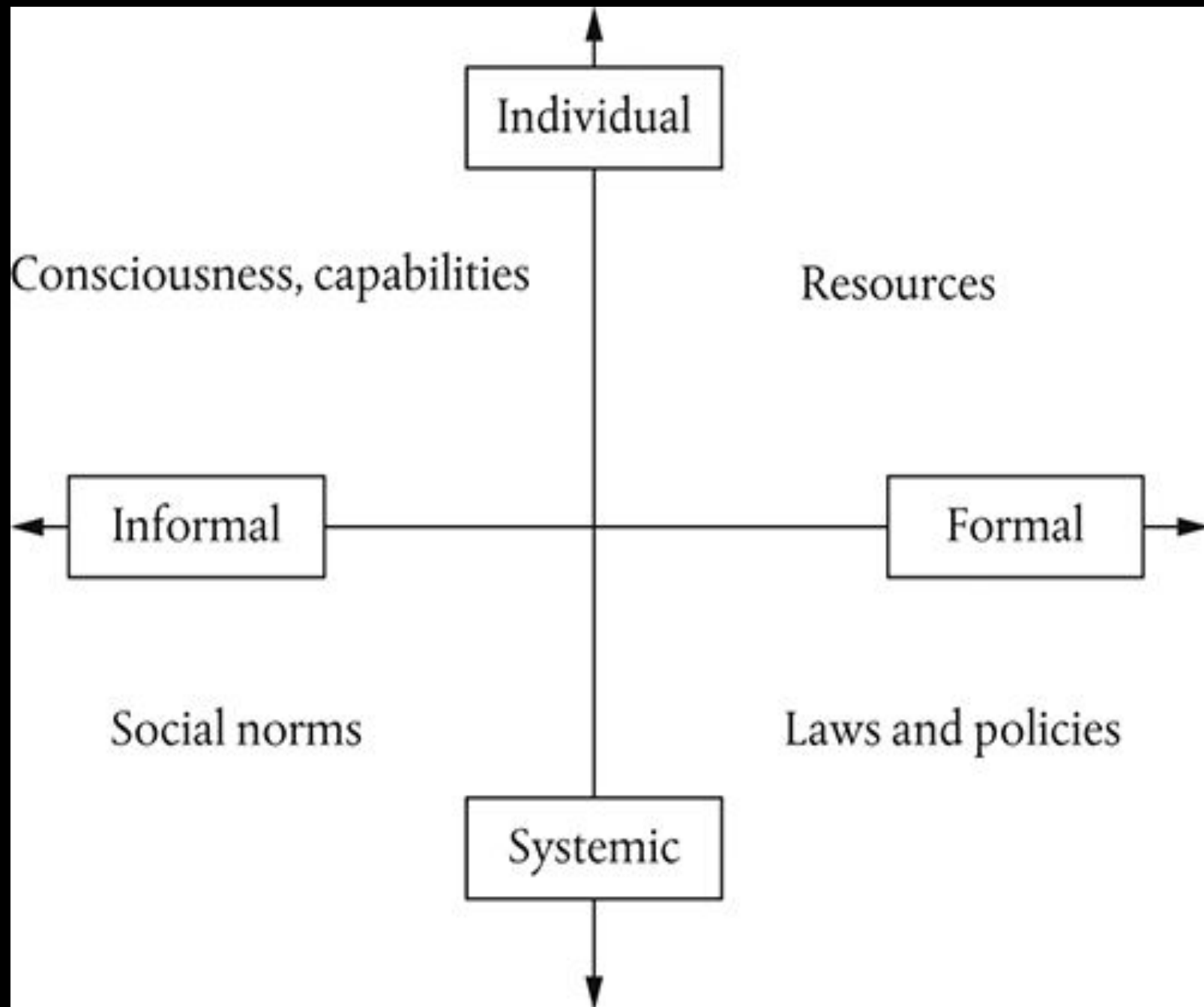



Goals for government: what sort of country do we want to be?

Measure what matters: asking how are different groups faring? (who's winning & who's losing under the current set up?)

Wellbeing approach: understand *why?*

Go upstream to ask what are the root causes of inequalities, ecosystem breakdown etc?

Wellbeing approach to policy design: what do we need more of & what less of?
How can policy instruments (tax, regs, incentives etc) help get there?

Wellbeing budget: fund this investment & helps shape fiscal incentives accordingly

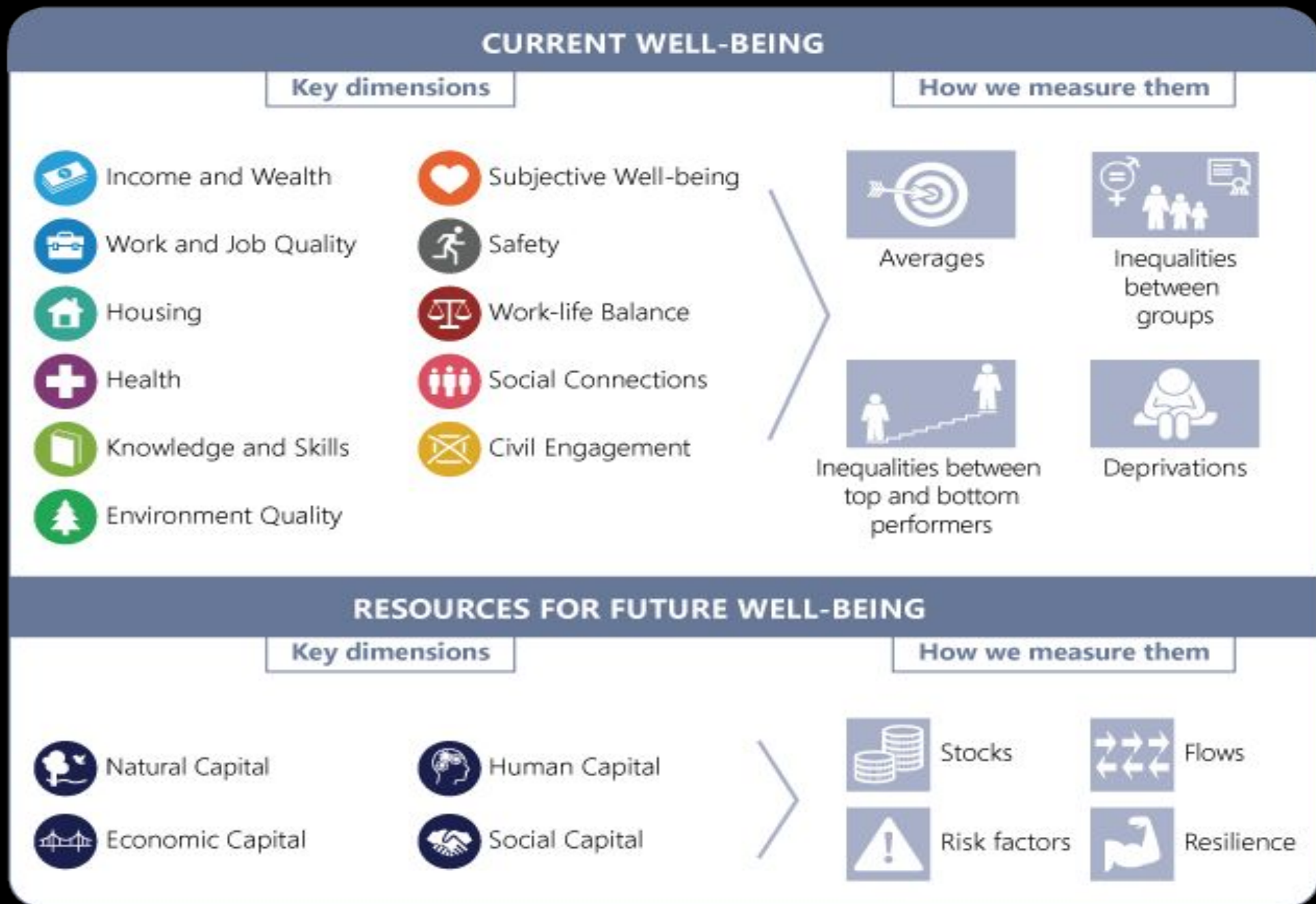
National actions to transition to a wellbeing economy

Building blocks of Wellbeing Economy approach*	Examples of key SG strategies, targets, legislation and policies to transition to a Wellbeing Economy
Purpose: Vision and outcomes	National Performance Framework ('Scotland's Wellbeing Framework') Climate Change Plan; Environment Strategy; Children & Families Wellbeing Outcomes
Objectives and targets	e.g. targets for GHG emissions, biodiversity, child poverty...
Prevention (early, upstream intervention)	Just Transition to Net Zero, Scottish National Investment Bank, Fair Work Nation, Business Purpose, Centre of Excellence on Equalities and Human Rights, Tackling Child Poverty Delivery Plan, Circular Economy Bill, Wellbeing & Sustainable Development Bill, Future Generation Commission/er, Natural Capital investment, Public Service reform, Whole Family Wellbeing Fund, Place based investment programme, Social Innovation Partnership
'Pre-distribution' (ownership of wealth/assets)	Land Reform Bill, Community Wealth Building , review of business models & increasing enterprises with alternative models, review on public ownership strategy (for public good)
People power (participative democracy, budgeting & decision making)	Community Empowerment Act, citizens assemblies, Place-based Wellbeing Economy Toolkit , person-centred services (Public Service Reform), co-creation, lived experience, partnership approach to NSET delivery...
Measurement	National Indicators, Wellbeing Economy Monitor , SHANARRI (children & families wellbeing)

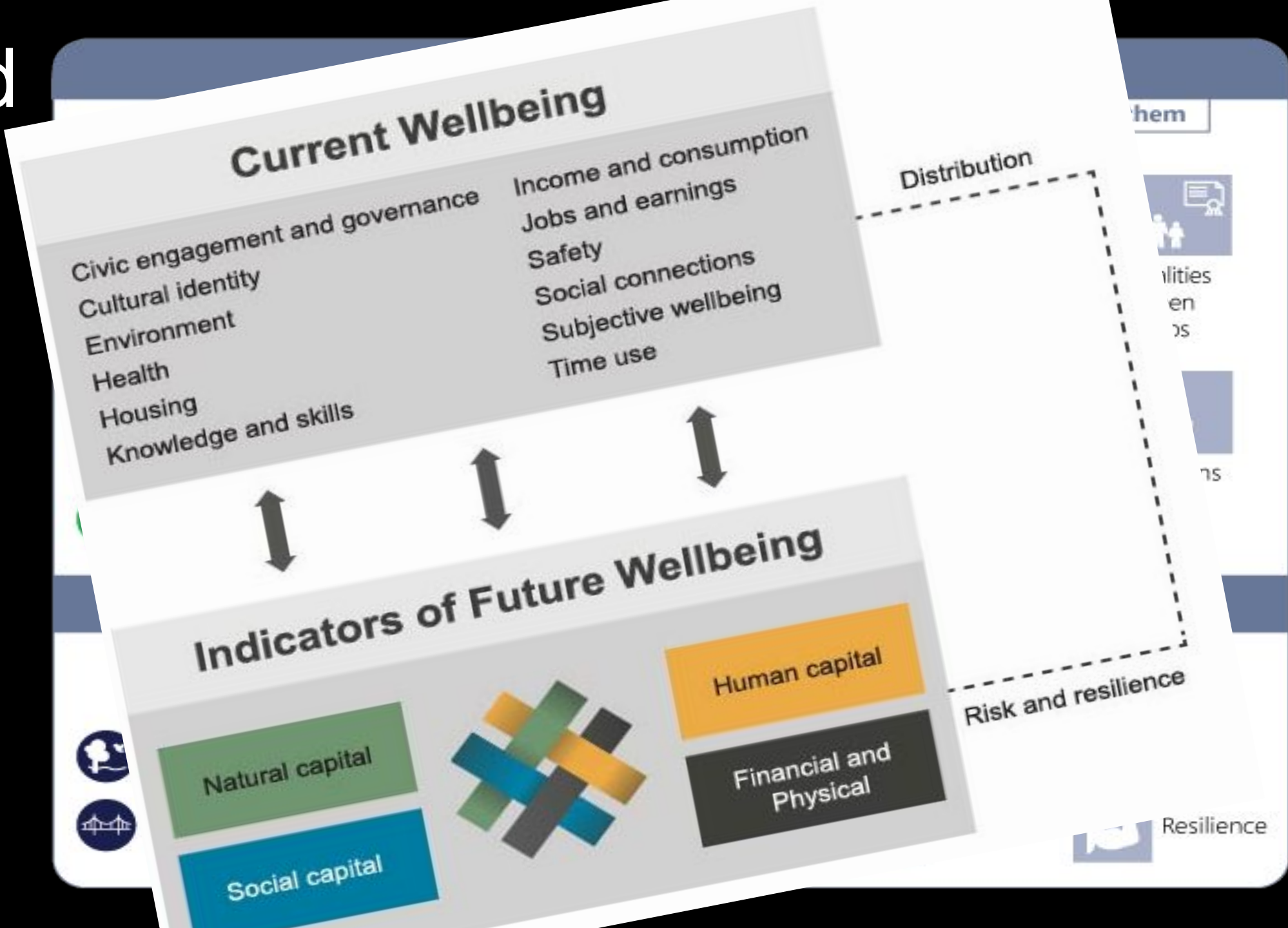

A society that sustainably uses natural and financial resources, protects and repairs the environment and builds resilience to combat challenges.

Cohesive

A society that supports connections with family, friends and the community, values diversity, promotes belonging and culture.

Prosperous

A society that has a dynamic, strong economy, invests in people's skills and education, and provides broad opportunities for employment and well-paid, secure jobs.

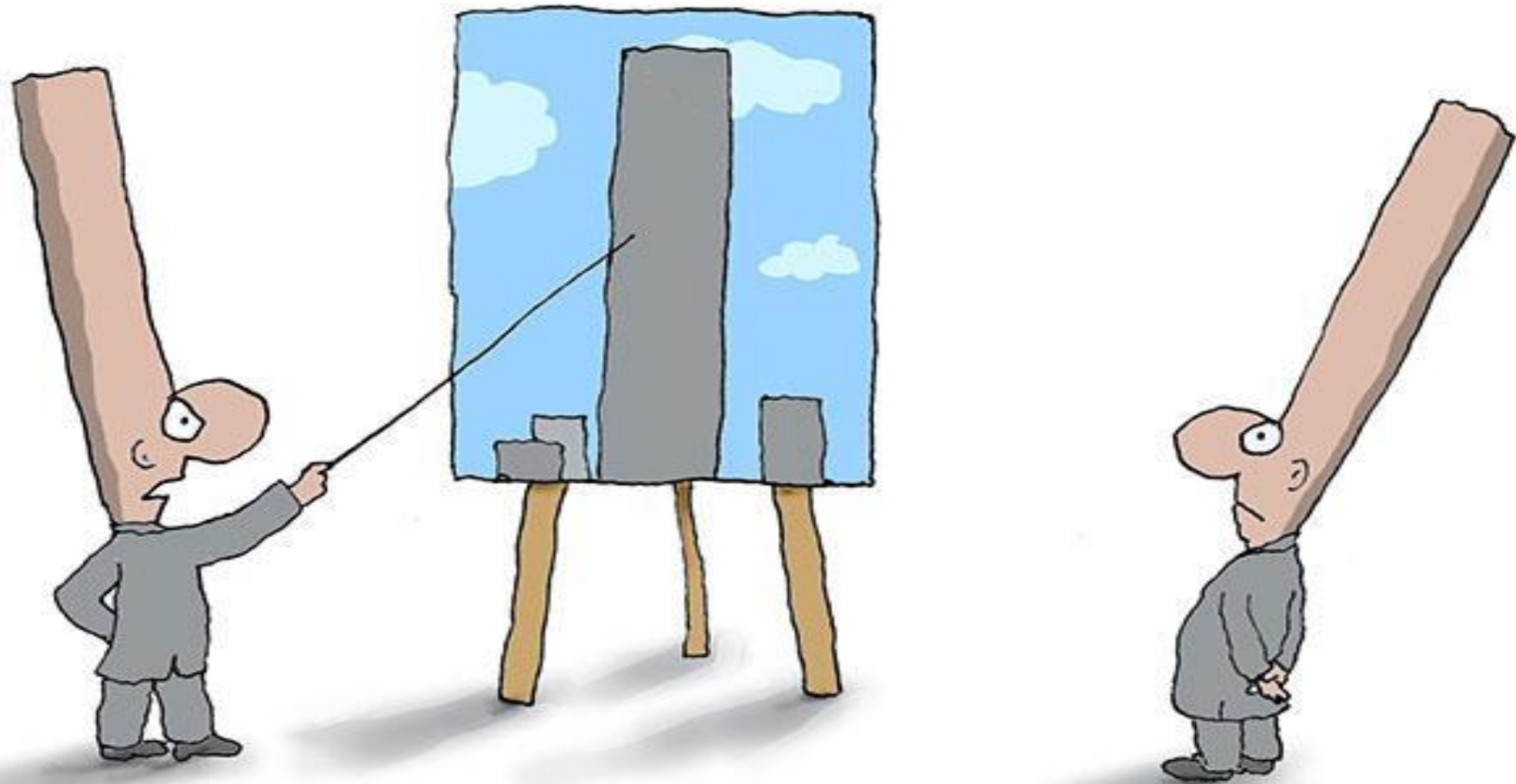
Hopeful signs?


- Opinion polls & deliberative democracy exercises show people want an economy that meets their needs
- Governments (or some people in govts!) know BAU isn't good enough (EP & Iceland conferences)
- The debate (in some quarters) has moved beyond statistics
- ESG & plenty of businesses show the private sector can be part of positive change
- Doughnut Economics in cities & community wealth building show a Wellbeing Economy being implemented in localities
- Some funders are grappling with system change

And in Australia?

- Lots of enterprises & communities are showing what is possible
- State & territory govs are moving on measurements & outcomes budgeting; Federal catching up (but not yet clear will go as far as needed – already risking skipping a step)
- The general debate is thin & far from the mainstream (in contrast to EU, the UK nations, OECD work etc)
- There is often an emotional push back to the question of growth & beyond GDP
